The proposed TIP Amendments are as follows:

FY 2022

Update – Cost Increase

I-79 Bridge Rehabilitations – Rehab Bridges, Design/Build – Construction. Project number U384791097400. Federal funds \$63,270,000 (from \$40,139,040); total funds \$70,300,000 (from \$50,173,800).

FY 2023

West Virginia University

West Virginia University requested to utilize the funds totaling \$1,674,325.00 for SGR activities that will improve and maintain PRT vehicles, stations, and guideway infrastructure. The \$1,674,325.00 combines the State of Good Repairs (SGR) 5337 grant apportionments of \$887,577.00 from FFY 2020 and the \$786,748.00 from the FFY21. The projects include:

ALI 12.7A.00 Preventative Maintenance, \$ 150,000.00
ALI 12.44.03 Rehab/Renovation – Admin/Maintenance Facility, \$ 50,000.00
ALI 12.24.07 Rehab/Renovation PRT Guideway, \$ 537,162.50
ALI 12.34.02 Rehab/Renovation PRT Passenger Stations, \$ 537,162.50
ALI 12.44.20, \$ 400,000.00
